

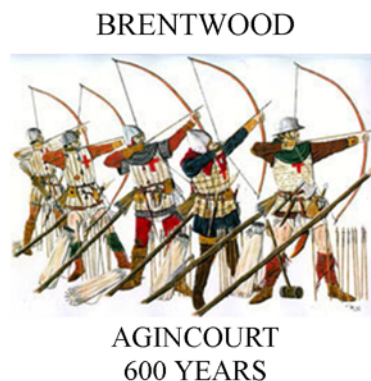
The anniversary falls on 25th October.
